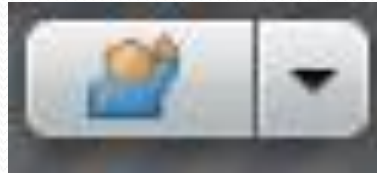

- Then release once you are done

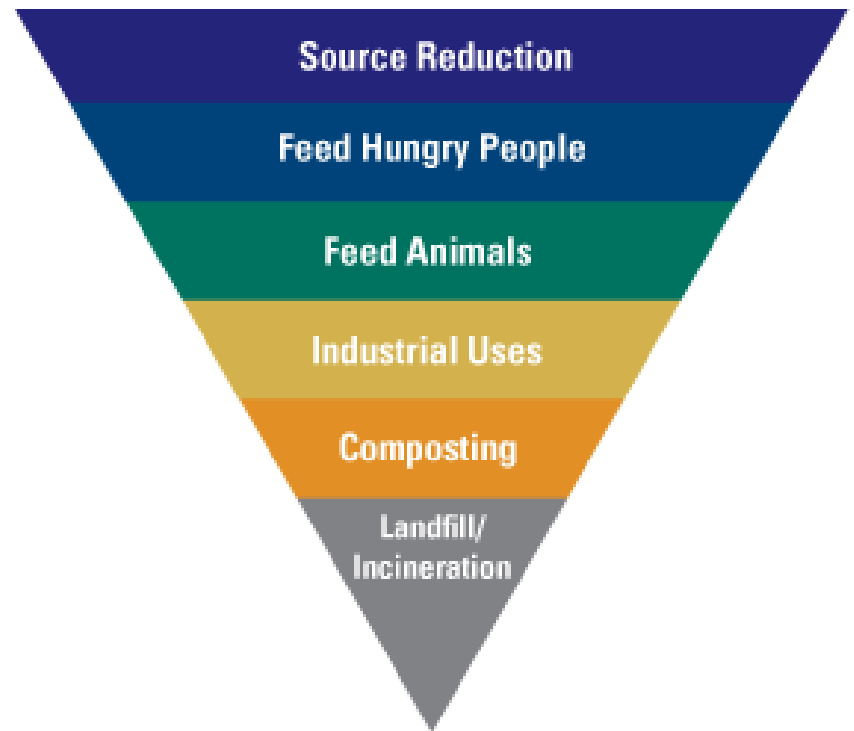
